Elementary Guidance Counselor-Primary Responsibilities

- ☐ Provide social skills instruction to students in grades K-5 through monthly classroom guidance lessons (6 week sessions), small groups, and individual student meetings
- Increase career awareness (K-5) through the delivery of classroom lessons aligned to the PA Career Education and Work standards
- Verify and maintain all student records documenting student progress towards meeting the Future Ready PA Index Career Readiness Indicator requirements
- Participate in Instructional Support Team (IST), IEP, 504, SAP and coordinated services meetings
- Conference/consult with administrators and teachers daily regarding student progress and interventions
- Perform student classroom observations for data collection on students

Elementary Guidance Counselor-Primary Responsibilities

- Meet with students individually to identify and address family, academic, behavioral and/or social-emotional concerns that create barriers to student learning and/or personal growth
- Lead student mediation meetings to diffuse conflict between students to avoid escalation of conflict
- Triage and address mental health needs of students through student meetings, daily check in/check outs, communication with parents, referrals to school psychologists, and connecting students and parents to community resources
- Collaborate with outside agencies to provide resources and services for students based on needs
- Welcome new students and families to the district through the facilitation of new student/kindergarten orientation; facilitate student placements

Elementary Guidance Counselor-Primary Responsibilities

- Collaborate with middle school staff to coordinate middle school transition activities
- Organize and deliver timely and relevant programming to parents and teachers through parent events and teacher professional development workshop
- Implement Positive Behavioral Support Interventions in the building
- Serve on school-based leadership and improvement teams, district-level committees and maintain professional association memberships
- Participate on district level school counseling committees (i.e. K-12 Guidance Planning team, Bullying Prevention committee, etc.) to maintain a quality comprehensive school counseling program that proactively addresses student academic, personal/social and career development
